AA2

AA1. Child Handler 6yrs to 10yrs

 Open to all children in this age group with ponies up to and including 1.50m.
 Competitors will be judged on their ability to show their pony in hand.
 Conformation of the pony will <u>not</u> be taken into account.

NO STALLIONS MAY BE SHOWN

Child/Junior Handler 11yrs – 15yrs Open to all competitors in this age group. Competitors will be judged on their ability to show their horse/pony in hand. Conformation of the horse/pony will <u>not</u> be taken into account.

NO STALLIONS MAY BE SHOWN

AA3 Groom Handler Class:

Handlers class open to all bone-fide grooms showing horses/ponies. Class will be judged on turnout & the ability of the handler to show their horse/pony. Conformation will **not** be taken into account.

First & Second prizewinners to compete in class 5008 "Groom Handler of the Year"

AA4 Veteran Horses / Ponies:

In-hand class for retired horses/ponies over the age of 18 years. No cross entries with any other class! (Horses may **not** be currently competitive)

AA5 Strictly Comes Showing – with a difference

A freestyle to music competition for all different breeds of Show Horses. This class is designed to promote the correct training and production of the Show Horse. (Rules available on <u>www.showingsa.co.za</u>) However **for this show only** the mark for Conformation will be replaced by a mark for "showmanship".

Competitors will be allowed to ride in *correct dress* for their Discipline e.g. Western Riding (It is NOT a fancy dress class) and the test may include movements suitable for that breed.

AA6 Star of the Future

A Show Riding Horse/Pony class open only to Non-Members of SASA

The class will be judged as a SASA Show riding class and SASA rules for tack & turnout will apply. The winner of this class will compete in the Supreme Riding Championship on Sunday and will be eligible to enter two SASA classes at affiliated shows during the year without paying SASA membership. The Class will be split into Pony Riders & Junior/Adult if entries warrant.

AA7 Racehorse to Show Horse

A Novice Show Riding Horse class open to all ex-racehorses that have been retired from racing for 3yrs or less. Schooling, manners & conformation will be judged.

- 1. Open to members and non-members of SASA. Membership and Registration Requirements Please see note on Page 3 re: Vaccinations and immunization requirements.
- 2. Height certificates: Entries in height restricted classes must be supported by copy(s) of height certificate which <u>MUST</u> be attached to the entry forms.
- 3. Stallions, mares and geldings entered <u>must be 3yrs and over</u>. The age of the horse / pony / rider is taken as at the first day of the show.
- 4. No cross entry of ridden classes with SASA Novice & Open classes will be allowed. Cross entry with SASA Riding Horse classes (section 2100) will be allowed.
- 5. In Ridden classes there are no height restrictions of horse/pony for either Pony Rider or Junior/Adult classes; however suitability of horse/pony to rider may be taken into account.

BREED CLASSES

- 500 Broodmare with foal at foot, no height restriction. Foal must be entered in class 501. Not open to mares which have produced a foal by embryo transplant or to surrogate mares. (No cross entry with classes 507-510)
- 501 Foal at foot not under 8 weeks and not over 8 months, unweaned. Foal to enter the arena with dam, which must be entered in class 500. (no cross entry with class 502)
- 502 Young stock, either sex, under 12 months
- 503 Young stock wither sex, 1yr but under 2yrs
- 504 Young stock fillies 2yrs but under 3yrs
- 505 Young stock colts 2yrs but under 3yrs
